

ELIZABETH STREET - BETWEEN LITTLE BOURKE AND LONSDALE STREETS Streetscape improvement works – western side only

The City of Melbourne will be undertaking works to improve the environment on the **western side only** of this section of Elizabeth Street. A concept plan for the works is enclosed.

This project is part of the City of Melbourne's Streetscape Improvements Program, which aims to upgrade streets and laneways through road and footpath works, landscaping and other improvements.

The works

The planned changes include:

- replacing existing asphalt footpath with bluestone pavement
- upgrading all ramps and crossings to meet Disability Discrimination Act requirements
- upgrading existing seats, bins and bike racks to stainless steel and the installation of additional street furniture
- retaining and protecting existing trees by widening tree plots and resurfacing plots with porous pavement.

The cost and timing

The \$450,000 project is planned to commence in mid-September 2014 and will take approximately 8 weeks to complete (weather permitting). Closer to the start of construction, information confirming the start date and timing of the works will be delivered to properties along this section of Elizabeth Street by our contractor Citywide.


