#### Notice of the preparation of an amendment

##### Amendment C394melb

Melbourne City Council as Planning Authority has prepared Amendment C394melb to the Melbourne Planning Scheme.

The Amendment applies to three (3) places within the study area of the Fishermans Bend In-depth Heritage Review 2021 (the Review), as listed below:

- Former Kraft Vegemite Factory – 1 Vegemite Way, Port Melbourne
- Electricity Substation – 224-236 (Part) Salmon Street, Port Melbourne
- Shed 21 - 206 Lorimer Street, Docklands

The amendment proposes to introduce the Heritage Overlay control to each of these sites, as locally significant individual heritage places.

You may inspect the amendment, any documents that support the amendment and the explanatory report about the amendment, free of charge, at the following locations:

Any person who may be affected by the amendment may make a submission to the planning authority about the amendment. Submissions must be made in writing giving the submitter's name and contact address, clearly stating the grounds on which the amendment is supported or opposed and indicating what changes (if any) the submitter wishes to make.

Name and contact details of submitters are required for council to consider submissions and to notify such persons of the opportunity to attend council meetings and any public hearing held to consider submissions. The closing date for submissions is Thursday 8 July 2021. A submission must be sent to the Team Leader Heritage Strategy, City of Melbourne and lodged either:
