

PARKING IN THE CITY FAST FACTS

Draft Parking and Kerbside Management Plan

Good parking management keeps our city moving. As more people embrace Melbourne's new rhythm, we want parking to be simpler, fairer and more reliable for those who need to drive into the city.

On-street parking spaces are in high demand and used in many different ways:



City access for people and goods

Loading, bus stops, pick up/drop off



Vehicle parking

Car, motorbike, accessible and bike parking



City uses

Outdoor dining, construction zones, city greening

- **760,000** trips are made into and within the city by vehicles each day, so parking is in high demand.
- Just **5%** of the city's total parking capacity is on-street paid parking, while more than **90%** is off-street parking.
- **95%** of people look for an on-street space first, rather than go direct to off-street parking.
- Of these, more than **80%** find it difficult to find an on-street space, with **a third** of drivers ending up in off-street parking.
- Up to **30%** of traffic in the CBD is cruising to find a car park.

We know parking in the city is important to many people in the community – that's why we're working with businesses, residents and drivers to get the balance right.
