






GENERAL LAYOUT PLAN

DESIGN GUIDANCE

- OBJECTIVES which set out the goals for Fishermans Bend: the strategic outcomes that <u>must</u> be attained through developments
- GUIDELINES are the instructions on how these objectives <u>may</u> be achieved.

DEVELOPER CONTRIBUTIONS PLAN

 An overlay that requires developers to pay close to \$16,000 per dwelling when they redevelop their property.


WHERE DID THIS PLAN COME FROM?

- Positioning Lorimer and the Fishermans Bend Urban Renewal Area as an extension of the Capital City to create jobs











WHY ARE WE DOING A STRUCTURE PLAN?

TO GUIDE THE DEVELOPMENT OF LORIMER TOWARDS A SUCCESSFUL OUTCOMES

- 1. The creation of 21st century jobs
- 2. A great place for families
- 3. The timely provision of infrastructure
- 4. A high-quality built environment
- 5. A place that is easy to get around

- 6. Smart environmental solutions
- 7. A vibrant, mix of uses and activities
- 8. Environmental constraints addressed
- 9. Distinctive and diverse neighbourhoods
- 10. Strong partnerships and effective governance

KEY ELEMENTS OF THE STRUCTURE PLAN

- Determine population forecasts for Lorimer
- Test urban design outcomes
- Identify infrastructure needs for Lorimer eg. public transport, community facilities, schools, parks
- Establish an implementation plan that considers how the area will transition, funding and delivery arrangements

WHAT WE HAVE HEARD TO DATE

- Concerns about the proposed tram bridge including potential issues with boat access, noise, visual impact, loss of open space (Point Park) and impacts on local businesses.
- That there is concern about the numbers of people coming in, the scale of developments and whether there will be sufficient community services and open space.
- That you want to have a say.
