The visible increase in homelessness in the city in the last 3 or so years is highly correlated with a lack of affordable housing and homelessness services. Studies and experts from places like Justice Connect and Melbourne City Mission confirm this view, that homelessness will only decrease with an increase in support services. There are 33,000 people already on waiting lists for public housing, so where do we expect these people to go?

These proposed laws to remove the homeless from the CBD are not only unjust and cruel, but in my view also completely ineffective. It is extremely naive to think that forcing the homeless out of the city will solve the ongoing homelessness crisis in Melbourne.

This will only move the problem into other suburbs, causing greater issues because these suburbs are less able to support the homeless, with less access to services, shelters, food and the like. This will lead only to further costs, when homeless people inevitably need to be taken to hospital for exposure to the elements and the like.

These costs may not be your problem as a city council, however instead of simply moving the problem of homelessness out of your sight, you should be working with the state government to provide affordable housing to these people, through schemes such as requiring major residential developments to include affordable housing, and more contributions to homelessness shelters and services angled at helping homeless people get back on their feet and reintegrated into our society.

I urge you as councillors elected by the public to consider the long term consequences of your actions and policies, rather than just the short term political point scoring at the expense of society's most vulnerable.

Firstly, the evidence shows that most homeless people are NOT a threat to public safety. I am concerned that Melbourne City Council is prioritising the tidyness of the city over the health and wellbeing of vulnerable members of OUR community.

Secondly, it makes no sense at all to collect up the belongings of homeless people, and make them then pay a fine to get those belongings back when so many of them won't have the money to pay those fines.

Thirdly, the main reason that most homeless people are homeless is through a lack of affordable, accessible housing. There are also a large number of people homeless due to personal trauma and family violence. There are tens of thousands of Victorians on public housing waiting lists currently. I believe a much better step towards a solution is for the City of Melbourne to invest more in sustainable housing. AND to require that ALL big developments in the city have affordable housing, as part of the planning permission process. The City of Melbourne should also be lobbying the Victorian Government to fund more affordable and public housing.

I don't want to live in a community which criminalises the behaviour of people who are down on their luck and stigmatises people who are already vulnerable.

I urge you, please, not to introduce this new law.

As I understand it, this proposed law is essentially a ban on homelessness in the city. Given that the key driver of homelessness in the city is a lack of affordable housing, and that there are current 33,000 people on public housing waiting lists in Victoria, banning homelessness is unlikely to achieve anything other than further stigmatising homeless people, who are already amongst the most vulnerable members of our society. Expert bodies, including the Council for Homeless Persons and Melbourne City Mission, agree that this ban will not work.

Instead of hitting people while they're down, may I suggest that it would be far more sensible, as well as more compassionate, for the City of Melbourne to:

- invest in more affordable housing;
- require all major developments within the city to contribute to affordable housing;
- call on the Victorian Government to invest more in public housing; and
- dedicate substantially more funding to support and health services that can address the reasons people find themselves homeless to begin with.

I don't want to be part of a society that considers ill health, poverty and misfortune a crime. I believe that the way we treat the most vulnerable members of our society is the clearest reflection of our own level of civilisation.

Eventually, these people will have nowhere to sleep at all, whereupon we can cheerfully drive them off a cliff's edge to the sea below. That surely solves the problem. There must be a better way to help these unfortunate people.

People living on the streets find it hard to move out of homelessness, in part because they are living on the streets. I do not believe they are living there because it is a fun, social thing to do. I believe it is an act of desperation because there is no alternative, so they come to the city.

They come to the city for safety. There is lighting and the streets are reliable. There are often people around. I walk home quite often through the city and there is a definite feeling of safety, for which Melbourne should be proud.

An unfortunate side effect of living rough is the lack of showers and washing facilities. It is impossible for someone to get a job if they smell and sometimes they do. We all would if forced to live this way. And, make no mistake, the lack of public housing for single people is a large part of this problem.

Instead of tossing them out -a cruel and heartless, and entirely unnecessary act - why not make it easier for them to keep clean? Institute shower blocks for them and lockers for their gear, which would clean up the streets. Allow them to have a place to be social. We are social beings.

Treat them as human and allow their humanity to show through. They are much more likely to get jobs and come back into mainstream life if they are embraced, than if they excluded.

The people who live and work in Melbourne do not feel the same way as you do, Mr Doyle and members of the council. We leave money and buy food. And we allow their vulnerability to touch our own.

I offer you this short story, called "Challenge," because that is often what is felt at first sight, before a person is really seen:

Out of the cover of the station it was stone cold. Beverley waited at the lights, happy she had put on her thick coat and scarf, and had remembered her hat and gloves for a change. "Good thing I'm wearing my furlined boots!" she thought, gladly. The lights changed. Beverley beetled across as quickly as her plump 57 year-old legs could go. She became one with the solid block of commuters moving northwards up Elizabeth Street at 8 a.m.

"Not a nice day at all," she told herself. "Everything's grey. The sky, not raining yet but it will, the road, and nearly all the clothes people are wearing. Very chilly, is it too. I'll have to make something good and hot tonight. Warm us all —" and then "Aghh — watch out! I've almost fall... Oh, my God, what's that?!" She recoiled quickly.

Beverley had almost stepped on a homeless person. A shiver ran through her and she braced herself against the window of Coles Express, barely keeping her balance. "Homeless. Just lying on the street now. Not even in a doorway." She breathed in quickly, heart racing. "Lucky I didn't hurt anything. Calm down, girl. Just a homeless person. More of them all the time. Whatever are we to do? I feel so stupid, but how was I expected to see them, just lying there?" She looked down at the person, not what she would usually do, but somehow unavoidable.

They were sound asleep; chest rising and lowering slightly. A male, she thought. A boy, well more a teenager. Late teens, still a bit fat like a baby, a few whiskers. Sleeping on the pavement like it were a bed. Oblivious to the noise of people and traffic, to smells of fried food and coffee, seeing nothing, touching cold, cold ground but untroubled. "I haven't looked at a boy so closely since my Stephen was a child," she reminisced and relaxed, her eyes moving over the child-man.

He had put out a pale grey cap for early morning donations, she noticed. The brightest, most perfectly arched and yellow, without blemish, banana was sitting in the hat. A wonder in itself. Beverley, as if by remote control, checked her purse for loose change and chose a \$5 note instead.

She tucked it under the banana. "Bless you, pet," she said to the boy, and rushed off to work.

Council's proposed amendment, under the guise of "protecting public amenity and disability access", goes too far beyond this stated aim. If the purpose of the amendment were such, the bylaw need only be amended to include such activity as an offence.

This amendment is clearly designed to achieve a more sinister aim: To give law enforcement officers the power to remove people sleeping on the street in Melbourne. This will do absolutely nothing to help those who have no option other than to sleep on the street. It will force them to move elsewhere, which simply relocates the 'problem'.

The amendment is purely punitive in nature and does nothing to make a positive change to the lives of those who have no other place to sleep. Council's efforts would be better spent liaising with law enforcement officers and making sure they are trained in assisting those who have nowhere to go, for example by providing them with current information on where to seek emergency shelter, and making homeless persons aware of the needs of those with limited mobility, rather than simply removing homeless persons or, worse still, fining them.

Introducing fines for possessions left unattended is also clearly a "punish only" solution. If the problem is that personal items occasionally restrict access, then the solution that causes least harm to all involved is to move the items in question out of the way, in a manner that causes the least inconvenience to all, and to have law enforcement officers explain the reasons for doing so. Taking punitive action is a waste of public resources, and impacts homeless persons disproportionately.

I love this city, and appreciate the work of the Council in striving to keep our city a safe, clean and healthy environment for residents, visitors and all who comes within the city's borders – including those who are homeless and at risk of homelessness.

I strongly oppose the proposed law reform as being unnecessary, politically driven and unlikely to succeed in tackling the problems at the heart of the current homeless population on our streets. In my view, the City of Melbourne should recognise that the homeless on our streets highlight problems that our society needs to tackle. Any attempt to move on the homeless, to remove belongings and encourage people away from the bright lights of the city only pushes the problem elsewhere – to places which are shadier, further from services, away from the public eye.

Homeless is a substantial problem for our city, and its problems and causes go far beyond the mandate of the City of Melbourne council. However, I would encourage the councillors to step up to this challenge, not by seeking to extend powers but by continuing to collaborate with other service providers and State and Federal governments to seek long-term solutions to homeless problems. As a ratepayer, there are many things my rates go to – including weekly sweeping of my quiet (already clean) suburban street – which are less pressing that homelessness. We should look afresh at whether, indeed, there is more we can be doing as a local community to help people, not shoo them on.

The homeless in large cities often aggregate towards the city center where services, charity and food are more readily available. By pushing the homeless away from the city, away from these scarce resources, and out of sight of homeless welfare groups, you will most certainly see a spike in homeless deaths. Sure the city might end up looking 'nicer' (by which you mean, less 'homeless') but in reality the city will become a much more hostile and unforgiving place.

Instead I believe we need to see investment in affordable housing and community welfare services, in particular domestic violence support centres, and the petitioning of federal government parties to contribute to helping with the issue of homelessness and social and economic dispossession in general. If we're wondering where the money might come from to fund such things, I've heard the Cayman Islands are a good place to start looking.

Every human life is valuable and every homeless person is still a member society. They only need our support to get back on their feet, or at least, to keep them safe. Please don't push the homeless even further towards the edges of our already harsh and hardened society, where most certainly, some of them will die.

I am deeply concerned that this action is being proposed in spite of the overwhelming evidence that it will not solve the problem of homelessness, and will actually make life harder for those already facing the almost insurmountable challenge of getting a house and a job when they are homeless.

Fundamentally, this action will not work because it does not address why people are hormeless in the first place.

People are not homeless for fun, or because it's easy money, or through choice. Homelessness is a complex problem, at the intersection of poverty, mental illness, a history of being a victim of abuse, and drug addiction.

Medical, social policy and legal experts agree: criminalising the homeless because they are homeless, threatening to remove the few possessions they have managed to hold on to, will only make things worse.

I live here in the city of Melbourne. I walk past people who are homeless every day. I am a young woman, and I know how it feels to experience street harassment and feel unsafe. But I have never felt unsafe because of the homeless. They are simply living the best they can, as we all are.

Sometimes I give money, sometimes I can't. Again, the homeless people I see and interact with are gentle, polite and in no way a threat.

I am appalled at the very idea that this action is proposed on aesthetic grounds: that homelessness is somehow so ugly that we should sweep it away.

Yes, it can be ugly. But only because we are a rich, wealthy city and yet we do not provide safe housing for all our citizens.

I would support a rate increase to help provide housing and support to homeless people. I will never support an action that would make their lives harder.

This action will not work because it does not address why people are homeless. It will only make everything worse. I expect more of my Council, and I expect more of my city.

And remember: no one chooses to be homeless. We are all of us only a few unlucky circumstances away from rock bottom. I have a chronic illness that prevents me from working full time. If I lacked family support, I could too easily be homeless. I urge you to consider how easily it could happen to you, and to wonder what you might need from others to help, rather than blame.
