They realised that it essentially cost the government/taxpayer far more to deal with the resulting costs of homelessness (mental health issues, run ins with police, emergency room visits, etc) than it does to actually house somebody.

There are complex systemic issues underlying this social problem and these need to be carefully considered as part of a broader, more effective solution. The reactive response planned by the Council is a political one, not a humanitarian one. It will shift the problem elsewhere and it will further entrench the questionable values of the "privileged" in our society.

As a social worker recently employed as a housing support worker in inner Melbourne I know the evidence states that this issue is going to worsen. We have significant housing problems in Victoria with very little investment into increasing social and public housing stock in recent decades.

Many women have been forced into homelessness or untenable housing after escaping domestic violence. Children are often involved. These are society's most vulnerable and we should not be using punitive measures against these people.

The homelessness paraphernalia that clutters the footpaths along the antisocial behaviour of a few individuals is unfortunate but there is a much greater invisible problem that should be the focus of our efforts. It seems that we have the resources to act speedily and decisively on "cleaning up the streets"; why can we not use these same resources to enable a more humanitarian outcome?

This action will not work because it does not address why people are homeless in the first place. It is a stop-gap measure that is ineffective and unnecessary.

For a lot of homeless people, the streets of the city are literally their home. It is understandable why this might be the case – it would be arguably safer to sleep rough in the city rather than in other locations such as secluded parks or under bridges. I don't believe that forcibly taking this safer space away from homeless individuals is the way to go. This is a knee-jerk, short-term solution that has no benefit other than to make Melbourne 'look' better.

The focus of the council's energies should be on finding a permanent and effective long-term solution to homelessness. Law proposals such as these only distract efforts from the real problem – that so many individuals are without a home – and the potential real solutions. The current system of public housing is obviously not working, with a waiting list of over 30 thousand individuals. Initiatives such as the Housing First program in the U.S. have shown to have a high success rate as well as reducing costs for the taxpayer and the government alike in the long run. Launch Housing seems to be planning a similar initiative in the west of Melbourne, which is a hopeful sign.

However, the responsibility to reduce homelessness doesn't just lie in the hands of charities – you, as the council, have the power to make change. Change in the public's attitude towards homelessness; change in the council and government's relative inaction upon this issue; and real change for the individuals who are suffering on our streets. Other than obvious suggestions such as investing more into affordable housing and putting pressure on the government to invest more in public housing, I do not have an immediate plan on how best to enact this change. Perhaps you too lack the answers on how best to tackle homelessness. But I hope that we can work on this issue together, without the introduction of a 'homeless ban' which serves only to further marginalise this group, one which has already been through enough.

After attending Melbourne City Council's recent meeting where a decision was made to make it an offence for a person to 'sleep rough' in the city I have genuine fears for those people who through various circumstances find themselves homeless and with no other alternative than to sleep on the hard surface of city streets.

I am horrified that a person who is in such dire circumstances could be seen to commit an offence should they attempt to enjoy something most of us, as human beings, take for granted e.g. laying on top of or underneath a warm blanket or perhaps being surrounded by a few very basic personal possessions. If, as we are led to believe, we are judged by the way we treat people less fortunate than ourselves then surely we can do better than demonising and maybe even subjecting people to financial costs for being in extreme poverty. It would be a heartless council indeed that even considers taking such steps as seizing the few items a homeless person may have in his possession.

A wealthy city such as Melbourne – purported to be one of the most livable cities in the world – must lead the way in solving the current issue of homelessness. No it may not be easy to find a solution which is acceptable to homeless people, ratepayers and the council, however, as homelessness may be an ever-increasing problem in the city it's time for a concerted effort to address the issue. Short-term fixes aren't the solution. Laws to criminalise homelessness are certainly not the solution as this will surely result in homeless people relocating to what may well be areas where their safety will be under increased risk.

My heartfelt plea to the City of Melbourne is to engage with State and Federal governments to ensure there is some real attention given to creating sufficient affordable long-term housing. None of us knows what we are to face in the future ...unless we are extremely privileged we could be forced to live on the streets due to an unforeseen change in our personal circumstances.

I have appreciated councils such as my own, Yarra, and Melbourne City Council for the till-now tolerating approach to the influx of homeless citizens, largely caused by the closing down of various hostels, the upsurge in poverty, lack of housing and crack down on welfare recipients leading many to go without a source of a living income.

It has seemed important to me that we, as a society, continue to remain in touch with the result of our economic and public policies and have the chance to stay in human connection to those sleeping rough in Swan Street, knowing about their situation, and whether they are receiving any support (e.g. a young woman from the country) or what food they need, etc.

Experienced voices like Justice Connect, the Council for Homeless Persons and Melbourne Citymission all agree the proposed ban won't work and will just further stigmatise homeless people as well as simply displace them somewhere else. It strikes me as quite a cowardly approach to our fellow citizens who have been given the 'rough end of the pineapple', and a defence against our own discomfort rather than an encouragement of good policy action.

The City of Melbourne could for example instead invest more in affordable housing; including requiring all major developments within the city to contribute to affordable housing.

The City of Melbourne could also urgently call on the Victorian Government to invest more in public housing.

Please find a more humane response to our fellow citizens who are homeless.

The city should be looking at the causes of homelessness and tackling them, ideally in consultation with experts. Experts like Justice Connect, the Council for Homeless Persons, Launch Housing and Melbourne City Mission have stated that this proposed ban won't work and will just further stigmatise homeless people.

I also ask you also not to allow for confiscation and disposal of unattended items, as well as a fine of \$388 for leaving items unattended. Again, this will make people's lives more difficult. People who are homeless are highly unlikely to have the money to pay fines.

The suggested changes will move people to other places, it will not solve their problems. It is an out of sight, out of mind, NIMBY proposal and I ask you instead to consult the experts and come up with a better plan.

While I live in Hoppers Crossing, I work in the CBD. Every day I see our homeless people. Sometimes I give them money, sometimes I buy them a meal, sometimes I learn something about them that allows me to find connections to services or people that can help. I always acknowledge them because these are not garbage on our streets, these are people.

Our people.

I am aware the number of homeless on our streets is growing. I have no doubt that the council understands that the problems that create homelessness are many and complex. There are no easy answers.

But BECAUSE of this, we should be working together to find real solutions. Sweeping our homeless people off the streets so that our fine city looks better isn't the answer. Removing our "problem" from the public eye isn't the answer.

I have, at points in my life, been homeless. The fact that I now earn over six figures never wipes away the memories of being alone, helpless and unable to resolve the issues that put me on the street. I was not a "bad" person. I was not a stupid person. I wasn't on drugs, or an alcoholic or mentally ill. Some of these are legitimate problems for our street people. Some are truly incapable of fitting into a 9 to 5 society and the kind of expectations that come with that. Some simply need help to break the cycle of homelessness.

I, as a citizen, as a tax payer, as a voter, understand this. I, in these capacities, choose to support our homeless, to support finding real solutions to very real problems.

I do not support "banning" our homeless, or fining people that everyone is quite aware do not have the means to pay such fines. This leads to no choice but to incarcerate people who have done nothing wrong except try to survive as best they can.

I ask that the council reconsider this proposal. I ask that the council instead put effort, time and money into real solutions that will benefit our homeless people and give them a chance to live with dignity, as all people deserve to have their dignity preserved. I ask that these people be given our understanding, our compassion and most of all, our help.

I would be willing to help in finding and providing real solutions in such ways as a citizen of Melbourne, Victoria and Australia can do.

All problems have solutions. The solutions are simply not always easy to find or implement. I believe this because I make a living out of solving problems.

I am shocked and saddened at this proposal, having just found out that my sister with mental illness has been living rough for months. Until you have a personal experience of this plight, you cannot understand the situation fully.

This action will not work because it does not address why people are homeless in the first place.

I shall attempt to précis the experience of one such homeless person & why she finds herself outcast and on the streets.

Over the last 16 years since my sister was first diagnosed with schizoaffective disorder it has been a shocking, heartbreaking traumatic journey companioning her (and then watching her) through her demise. I hope through giving an overview of her story, it may enlighten and en'heart'en those making policy.

At the onset my sister was told by her psychiatrist that outcomes often weren't good for people with her condition and was given only pharmacological options in her recovery plan. She went from a working, social, intelligent, caring, contributing, loving 30 year old woman with close relationships with family, friends, partner, housemates & dog, to a human shell, completely broken & isolated, with no relationships, a drug addiction, lost in the psychotic world & homeless.

Each early psychosis, she'd lose her job, use up all her (house-deposit) savings & have trouble maintaining her rented sharehouse. Each post-psychosis she'd work hard to get another job & get her life back together. But the themes of the psychosis were never addressed (through psychotherapy which works in other countries); the conflicting inner voices were never understood or integrated (with voice dialogue processes which have been found to be profoundly helpful); and the pharmaceuticals had intolerable side effects (for which she took other substances to control -eg marijuana to settle restless leg syndrome & help her sleep at night, ecstasy to help her 'feel' & not be a zombie & illicit drugs seemed to open a gateway back to psychosis where she felt compelled that she had to do planet-saving work or the world would die & it would all be her fault!)

Some medication side effects sadly made her look & act strange which further alienated her from society. Hospital visits were traumatic, adding each time to her growing trauma experiences & real help was not forthcoming. After a few years, somehow ice got into the mix and her personality changed.

The time came when she never came out of psychosis & wasn't able to go back to work, couldn't maintain her sharehouse, lost her friends & partner, and moved into a rooming house (cockroach infested & undesirable). Dogs weren't permitted so she had to give away her only beloved companion. She also became disconnected from family (who over the years experienced their own burnout & mental health issues from this experience & became characters of 'evil' in the landscape of her psychosis). Grief & trauma contributed to her malaise.

Due to her continuing state of unwellness over the years she was evicted. Her worker found other accommodation (with street workers & jail people) but it was very unsafe. Unbeknownst to her family (who were not kept in the loop) she became homeless.

While regular hospital visits helped reduce her extreme floridness temporarily, beds run out & after short times she was discharged (still florid) – the psychosis remained & nothing was ever done about her addiction (treatment currently is voluntary & she was always in an altered reality & never able to volunteer). She stopped having money for food so relies on a food van every few days for sustenance.

There has been no safe asylum to keep her off the streets (as all asylums were closed many years ago)... leaving her vulnerable to abuse, vagrancy, malnutrition and disconnection. The waiting lists are long for the few supported accommodation options and one has to volunteer for those, which, if she even had access I doubt she would be in enough reality to volunteer for.

So this is why she is homeless.

Decades ago I thought there was no reason for Australians to be homeless because we have 'welfare'. I've been made to eat those words through enlightenment to the great complexities of the issue – and this is only one story, one perspective. A heartbreaking, family shattering experience.

Last year through all the stress my mother developed psychosis & had to experience forced hospitalisation & extreme medicalisation. We are all terrified of a similar outcome. She's worked hard all year to develop alternative recovery options off her own back and get off medication, which she despised the side-effects of!

The problems are more complex than just 'moving the homeless along'. The homeless need destigmatising... to be heard, to be understood, to be helped. They need changes in the mental health Act, addiction treatment, more supported accommodation options, helpful asylum options again when they become a danger to themselves & vulnerable to drug pushers, more affordable housing options, alternative medical options (not just pharmacological)! And for heavens sake, some compassion & understanding in all of this.

It helps no one, sweeps broader social issues aside and criminalises those who already have enough to deal with.

Having been in need of support as a low income person while I was ill a few years ago I know how difficult it is and how thinly stretched the services are. A ban would only further stress services and use up police time on work that would demean the police in carrying it out.

I make this submission to directly participate in helping to voice the needs of our wider community, not merely for homeless persons. I am concerned with the harm this inevitably violent sweeping under the rug approach will have on our morale as a city that prides itself on progressive ideas and inclusivity. The shame of spending public funds locking people up instead of supporting them into housing is plain.

Safety is crucial for people experiencing homelessness and many feel safer in densely populated areas whereby they could be close to help if it's needed. There is no evidence to support banning ho

The city should not view them as a nuisance. The city should view them as people, who have every right to occupy public space as any other person does.

The main reason for homelessness is the lack of affordable housing options. The City should be lobbying the government to provide more affordable and accessible public and affordable housing.

The City has the power to make policy that could really improve the quality of people's lives, but instead it is choosing to introduce policy that will make vulnerable people's lives harder. It is cruel. Provide services to people that will make their lives better, not policy that will increase the power police have over them and their property.

There are currently 33 thousand people on public housing waiting lists in Victoria. This action makes no attempt to fix this serious human rights issue. This city needs to drastically rethink how it approaches homelessness. This is not the way.
