Existing oak avenue. New cobbled rumble strips on path at school approach. Mulch and decompaction of soils around existing oak trees Generous width coloured concrete paths to play areas. Colour & finish to match granitic gravel. Protect existing trees. Serpentine bike rack. Varying size loops for 30 (max.) bikes or scooters. South Yarra Primary School Entrance Sunken stormwater detention area. Gravel under existing trees & low dry shade plants. New cobbled rumble strips on path at playground approach. Asphalt causeway with basalt stone edging (max 300mm above detention basin) New edges and paths will be designed to slow cyclists down before exiting the park, improving safety and pedestrian/cyclist interaction. Paths will be separated shared use entry and exit with removable bollard for maintenance and emergency access. Entry signage. Kerb outstand with bluestone cobble paving.
