### **Hearing arrangements – Melbourne Planning Scheme Amendment C278**

Given the concerns about Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) and its potential impacts on conducting public hearings, the Panel issued directions on 12 March 2020 which included the following:

### **Scheduled hearings**

- Please be aware that the Panel may reschedule, postpone or cancel face-to-face scheduled hearings at short notice if there is a known risk to people attending from COVID-19 or on the advice of Victorian health authorities and the Victorian State Government.
- 2. Scheduled and new hearings may be arranged through video or phone conference where practicable.

The Panel has now determined that this matter will proceed on the papers as far as reasonably practicable, consistent with the requirements of procedural fairness.

The Panel has prepared a revised Hearing program and draft directions for the future conduct of the matter on the papers. These are attached, along with an updated Distribution List. Two new parties have been added to the Distribution List, with changes highlighted in yellow.

Parties must advise the Panel of any concerns or clarification about the proposed Hearing program or process by **4.00pm on Friday 27 March 2020**. This includes any party who wishes to present submissions or evidence via video or phone conference, or to conduct cross examination of any witness via video or phone conference.

Any party proposing a video or phone conference must put forward a detailed proposal as to how that will occur, including a suggested time and date, the technology platform proposed and a method for involving the Panel members and other parties who may wish to participate.

After considering any responses, the Panel will issue a final version of the revised Hearing program and directions.

The Panel is aware that current restrictions may be impacting parties' ability to carry out business as usual. Should you anticipate difficulties meeting a deadline specified in the Panel's directions at any time throughout the Hearing, please advise Planning Panels Victoria as soon as possible.
