STEWART STREET, MELBOURNE Streetscape improvement works

The City of Melbourne is proposing road and footpath works to improve the environment in Stewart Street, between Franklin and A'Beckett streets, as outlined in the attached plan.

The proposal

The proposed changes in Stewart Street would include:

- **Footpath widening:** widening a section of footpath on the eastern side of Stewart Street, towards the intersection with Franklin Street, to match the width of the footpath adjacent to the recent RMIT University development
- **Parking changes:** removal of the three parking spaces on the eastern side of Stewart Street to allow the footpath to be widened

Note: after the works there will be 'No Stopping' restrictions along the entire length of both sides of Stewart Street, between Franklin and A'Beckett streets.

• **Footpath works:** Conversion of existing asphalt footpath to bluestone to fill the gaps between existing bluestone paving in Stewart Street

Note: at this stage we will not be undertaking any work on the footpath in front of RMIT University on the western side of Stewart Street. Any work we do now might be damaged by future construction works at this site. This footpath will remain asphalt until we know more about what is planned.

- Road works: resurfacing of the roadway and
- Kerb and channel: renewing the bluestone kerb and channel.

While we investigated the possibility of providing trees on the eastern side of Stewart Street, in the section where we are proposing to widen the footpath, this was not possible as the footpath would be too narrow to accommodate planting.

The cost and timing

The \$200,000 improvement works in Stewart Street are planned to commence in January 2016. These works are expected to be complete by the end of Februray 2016 (weather permitting). Closer to the start of construction, properties along this section of Stewart Street will receive information confirming the start date and timing of the works from our contractor Citywide.




