Streetscape improvement works

The City of Melbourne is proposing works to improve the environment in the above section of William Street. We welcome your feedback on the enclosed concept plan.

The City of Melbourne is upgrading many of its streets as part of the Streetscape Improvements Program, which aims to enhance our streets and laneways through road and footpath works, landscaping and other improvements.

The proposal

The proposed streetscaping will improve this section of William Street for residents, businesses and visitors by:

- upgrading asphalt footpaths to sawn bluestone paving
- installing new stainless steel rubbish and recycling bins
- upgrading existing access ramp with tactile ground surface indicators to facilitate access for people with a sight impairment
- upgrading existing tree plots with bluestone edging and porous pavement.

The cost and timing

The \$300,000 project is planned to commence in early April 2016 and will take approximately four weeks to complete.

Closer to the start of construction, properties along this section of William Street will receive information confirming the start date and timing of the works from our contractor Citywide.
