Before the Hearing

Council Part A Submission

- 1. Council must circulate to all parties on the distribution list its 'Part A Submission' by **2.00pm on Thursday 21 February 2019**. This should include:
 - a. background to the Amendment
 - b. chronology of events
 - c. strategic context and assessment
 - d. identification of the issues raised in submissions and its response.

Note: At the Hearing, Council's 'Part A Submission' will be taken as read by all parties. Council should allow time on Day 2 for questions of clarification from the Panel.

Site visits

- 2. Council must circulate to all parties on the distribution list an itinerary of sites that will be visited on Day 1 of the Hearing by **2.00pm on Thursday 21 February 2019.**
- 3. Parties must inform Planning Panels Victoria whether they wish to attend the site visit on Day 1 of the Hearing by **Tuesday 26 February 2019.**
- 4. The Panel will provide, by on Thursday 14 February 2019, a list of sites in the city which the Expert Witnesses should familiarise themselves in order to facilitate any questions at the Public Hearing. Experts or Parties should advise the Panel by 2.00pm on Wednesday 13 February 2019 of any sites they think should be added to this list.

Working version of the Design and Development Overlay Schedule

- 5. Parties and experts should use the references in Document 1 or 2 to refer to specific provisions in the DDO in submissions or evidence.
- 6. Suggested changes to the DDO should be presented in track changes on Document 2.

Exchange of Expert Witness Reports

- 7. Expert witnesses reports must comply with the Planning Panels Victoria Guide to Expert Evidence (<u>https://www.planning.vic.gov.au/panels-and-committees/planning-panel-guides</u>).
- 8. Expert witness reports must be circulated by **2.00pm on Thursday 21 February 2019** in accordance with the attached Distribution List.
- 9. A copy of any expert witness report received must be made available on Council's website and at its office.
- 10. The Panel is to be provided with an 'unlocked' copy of any document circulated.

11. Experts should familiarise themselves with the sites referred to in Direction 4

Written Submissions at the Hearing

- 12. All parties should bring to the Hearing at least six (6) hard copies of additional written submissions and accompanying documents (i.e. photographs, plans). Copies of original submissions are not needed.
- 13. Written material presented at the Hearing should be two-hole punched and stapled (not bound).



- 14. Submissions (preferably in MS Word) should be emailed to the Panel after the Hearing at planning.panels@delwp.vic.gov.au.
- 15. Submissions and material presented at the Hearing including PowerPoint presentations are public documents and may be made available to other parties.

Council Part B Submission

- 16. At the Hearing, Council must provide through its 'Part B Submission':
 - a. a summary of the issues raised in submission
 - b. its response to evidence tabled
 - c. its final position on the Amendment.
- 17. It would assist the Panel if Council addresses:
 - a. The role of the external guidelines and whether they need to be incorporated
 - b. Any overlap with existing DDO3, DDO10 or Clause 22.20
 - c. The different roles for different types of pedestrian connection in achieving policy outcomes, including connections that may not be suitable for primary links but may add to the character of the city
 - d. Issues associated with ground floor servicing
 - e. Issues with ground level parking prohibition, parking floor to ceiling heights and any implications for ventilation if car park areas are skinned
 - f. The relationship with Amendment C323
 - g. Whether the use of the following terms in the DDO will be sufficiently clear in contested situations: 'small', 'narrow', 'deeply recessed', 'low-height', 'lower', 'long', 'limited number', 'large', 'minor'.

Aerials and maps

18. At the Hearing, Council should arrange for a map or maps showing:

- a. the location of submitters by submitter number
- b. the sites visited on Day 1 of the Hearing and the sites nominated by the Panel in Direction 4
- c. the location of 'Special Character Areas'
- d. those blocks that currently have an average block length of less than 100 metres.
