#### Melbourne Planning Scheme Amendment C278: Sunlight to Public Parks

#### Declarations

The members of the Panel made the following declarations at the Directions Hearing:

- Ms Carlisle declared that she is a regular user of Yarra Park and an occasional user of Fitzroy Gardens. She is not a resident or property owner in the City of Melbourne.
- Ms Carlisle declared that she chaired the recent panel for Amendment C309 to the Melbourne Planning Scheme, which seeks to implement the West Melbourne Structure Plan. That amendment (which is yet to be approved) proposes to apply Design and Development Overlays (DDOs) for the West Melbourne area which include controls designed to manage overshadowing of existing and planned open space in West Melbourne.



- Ms Carlisle declared on Ms Nervegna's behalf that she has sat on two past VCAT matters that dealt with overshadowing to public spaces in the City of Melbourne. Both related to overshadowing of Birrarung Marr:
  - DEXUS Property Group Ltd v Minister for Planning [2017] VCAT 619 this is one of the four VCAT cases reviewed in the Hodyl Report
  - 63 Exhibition Street Pty Ltd v Minister for Planning [2018] VCAT 861 63 Exhibition Street Pty Ltd has made a submission to the Amendment.
- Ms Carlisle declared on Ms Nervegna's behalf that she is sitting on a current VCAT matter, Nuvolink P/L v Melbourne CC & Ors, relating to a property at 86-90 Jolimont Street East Melbourne. The case deals with a number of issues including potential overshadowing to Yarra Park. Ms Nervegna made a declaration at the beginning of the VCAT hearing (which started on 24 February 2020) that she has been appointed to the Panel considering Amendment C278. All parties to the VCAT proceeding stated that they had no issue or objection with her continuing as a Tribunal member on the case and being a member on the C278 Panel.

No objections or concerns were raised at the Directions Hearing in relation to these declarations, but several parties requested the opportunity to review the VCAT decisions on which Ms Nervegna was a member before expressing a final position. The Panel agreed to this request (refer to Direction 1).

## **Before the Hearing**

#### Notification of concerns regarding declarations

1. Any party who, having reviewed the VCAT decisions referred to in the covering letter, has any concerns regarding Ms Nervegna's membership of the Panel must advise the Panel by **4.00pm on Friday 6 March 2020.** 

#### Notification of witnesses

 Any party who has not yet informed the Panel of the identity of any witness they intend to call must advise the Panel of the witness' name, position and area of expertise (where relevant) by 4.00pm on Friday 6 March 2020.

#### **Circulation of documents**

- 3. Documents should be circulated electronically, either via a file sharing service such as OneDrive or by email. Hard copy materials should only be provided in exceptional circumstances. Maps or plans are to be provided both electronically and in hard copy.
- 4. Council must circulate the link to the OneDrive account that it proposes to set up for the Hearing to parties on the Distribution List by **4.00pm on Thursday 26 March 2020.**
- 5. Any party who is not able to use OneDrive must inform Planning Panels Victoria by **4.00pm on Friday 6 March 2020**. Documents will be circulated to those parties directly via email.

#### **Council Part A submission**

- 6. Council must circulate a Part A submission to parties on the distribution list by **4.00pm on Thursday 26 March 2020** that includes:
  - a) a summary of the strategic context, including:
    - (i) relevant planning policies and controls, including Council's Open Space Strategy
    - (ii) other amendments that may be under preparation or recently approved that may impact on the Amendment
  - b) a detailed explanation of the strategic rationale for the Amendment
  - c) a detailed response to the issues raised in the authorisation letter from DELWP
  - d) an explanation of the concepts of 'existing shadow' and 'allowable shadow' and how they are calculated or determined
  - e) a consolidated map which shows:
    - (i) the location of the parks and their classification (Park Type 1, Park Type 2, Park Type 3East or Park Type 3West)
    - (ii) the excluded areas
    - (iii) key growth areas (including Arden Macaulay, the Parkville NEIC, Fishermans Bend and City North)
    - (iv) the location of submitters (including whether they are supporting or objecting)
  - f) a summary of the main issues raised in submissions
  - an explanation of the post-exhibition changes Council proposes to make to the Amendment in response to submissions, including a tracked version of the amendment documents that clearly identifies the proposed post-exhibition changes



- h) any other strategic material that Council intends to rely upon in support of the Amendment that has not yet been provided, or that might assist the Panel in its consideration of the Amendment
- i) a list of current permit applications that may impact on, or be impacted by, the Amendment.
- Note: Council's Part A submission will be taken as read by the Panel at the Hearing. Council should allow time for questions about its Part A submission on Day 1.

#### Information for site inspection

7. Council must provide to the Panel any modelling it has undertaken or commissioned for the parks and reserves listed in the attachment to these Directions headed 'Site Inspection' by **4.00pm on Thursday 26 March 2020.** 

#### Witness reports

- 8. A witness report must:
  - a) comply with the Guide to Expert Evidence (<u>https://www.planning.vic.gov.au/panels-and-</u> committees/planning-panel-guides)
  - b) not refer to any individual submitter by name if necessary, submitters should be referred to by submission number
  - c) be provided to the Panel as an unlocked document.
- 9. Council must circulate its witness reports and statements from current or former Council staff to parties on the distribution list by **4.00pm on Monday 30 March 2020**.
- 10. Other parties calling evidence must circulate their witness reports to parties on the distribution list by **4.00pm on Thursday 2 April 2020**.
- 11. Council must publish all witness reports and statements on its website.

### At the Hearing

#### Submissions and information

- 12. Parties should present material at the Hearing electronically. Electronic information presented at the Hearing must be:
  - a) circulated to parties on the distribution list by 9.00am on the morning the information is to be presented, either via the party's file sharing service or via direct email
  - b) (if the party is not intending to present the material from their own device using clickshare) brought to the Hearing Room on a USB stick in a clearly marked folder half an hour before the start of the day's hearing, to allow it to be uploaded onto the Hearing Room laptop.
- 13. If a paper copy is presented at the Hearing, at least fifteen (15) copies must be provided, twohole punched and stapled (not bound).
- 14. After presenting to the Panel, submissions (preferably in MS Word) must be emailed to <u>planning.panels@delwp.vic.gov.au</u> as an unlocked document.
- 15. All information presented at the Hearing is a public document unless the Panel directs otherwise.

- 16. At the Hearing, Council must provide a Part B submission that includes:
  - a) an explanation of the inter-relationship between the 'park types' in the DDO8 and the park hierarchy in the Open Space Strategy
  - b) an explanation of how the DDO8 was mapped

- c) an explanation of how the overshadowing controls in the DDO8 will interact with overshadowing controls in other parts of the planning scheme
- d) maps showing land which is proposed to be subject to more than one overshadowing control
- e) an explanation of how the Amendment (in particular the revised policy at Clause 22.02) impacts on current and future structures within parks, including major sporting facilities such as the MCG, Punt Road Oval and Ikon Park
- f) further information about the community consultation undertaken in 2016 (referred to in some submissions)
- g) Council's response to the issues raised in submissions
- h) Council's response to expert evidence
- i) any further changes Council proposes to make to the Amendment in response to expert evidence or submissions
- j) Council's final position on the Amendment.

#### Aerials and maps

17. At the Hearing, Council should arrange for:

- a) the latest aerial photography of the key parks affected by the Amendment and their surrounds
- b) large scale copies of the maps to be provided with the Part A and Part B submissions
- c) access to Council's GIS mapping system and/or NearMap.
